

Location

The conference will be held at the Eau Palm Beach Resort & Spa at 100 South Ocean Blvd., Manalapan, Florida 33462. The group room rate is \$185 per night. Single and double occupancy deluxe accommodations are available.

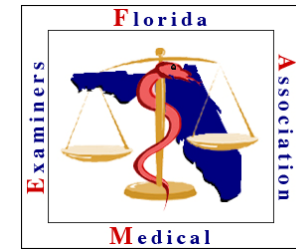
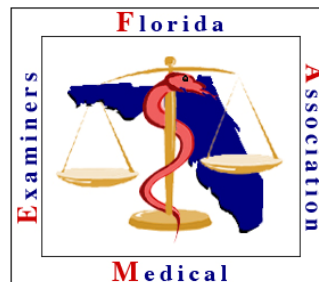
