

Location

The conference will be held at the Shores Resort and Spa at 2637 S. Atlantic Ave., Daytona Beach Shores, FL 32118. The group room rate is \$154. The resort and self parking fees are waived. Valet parking is \$17 per day.

Registration Fee

The registration deadline is July 1, 2015.

Note: The decision to allow this training to count toward mandatory retraining is an agency decision, not the individual officer's choice.

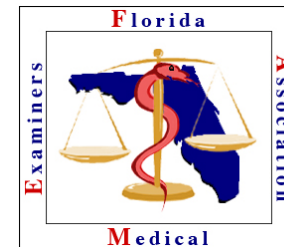
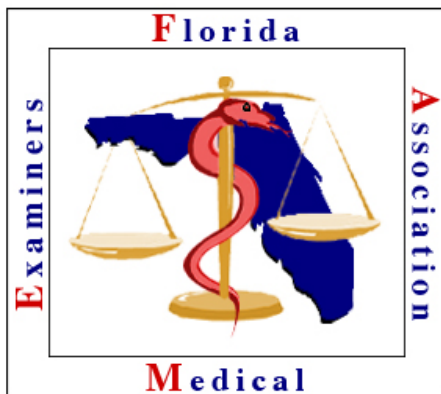
